Vivianne was admitted to the Health Facility Center of Mitwaba, a 78 km hike from her home. She received medical treatment and was provided RUTF during her two week stay in the hospital. Today, Vivianne pictured above (right), is healthy and doing well. She is playing and laughing. During a visit from our World Vision team, Vivianne's mother expressed her deep gratitude for our help and the RUTF she received. She told our team, with tears in her eyes, that if her daughter had not received help she would have died. Thank you for truly helping to give life back to Vivianne.
